

Revolutionary Leader

Choose a Revolutionary leader for your Project. You will need a biography about this leader of the American Revolution or Founding Father. You may choose to go to the library or find an ebook that you can download. If you have no access to a biography, you may use online research. Keep track of what resources you use. Start looking for a book now so that you will be able to start reading no later than day 40. Depending on the length of the book and how fast you read, you might want to start earlier. You need to plan ahead and make sure you have enough information for your project which is due on Day 50. Also, when you start reading you need to take notes!

Possible leaders you could choose: George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, Abigail Adams, Samuel Adams, Betty Ross, Paul Revere, Patrick Henry and Thomas Paine. For other ideas check the signers of Declaration of Independence. This is not an exhaustive list! There are many others you could choose.

You will create an 8 slide Power Point Presentation about your leader. The presentation should contain the following information:

The name of the Founding Father you have chosen and a picture or graphic of them

The major contribution of your Founding Father to founding of America

What exactly did this person participate in/lead/etc that was so revolutionary?

Include basic biographical details

A unique or little known fact about your choice

Bibliography page that lists the resource or resources (if you did additional research)

Discuss with your teacher a time and place that you can share your presentation with your family.
