

## EXEMPLARS from SUSPECTS

When it is in the best interest of the case not to disclose the contents of the questioned writing to potential suspects, investigators may request the suspects write a standardized passage that contains many of the common letter associations found in various English words as well as all of the capital letters of the alphabet, common punctuation, and the numbers "1" through "9."

The "London Letter" is a passage that meets this requirement so the 4 suspects were asked to write the passage, in cursive, for comparison to the evidence, the ransom letter.
