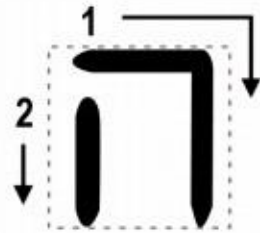


Hebrew Writing 11

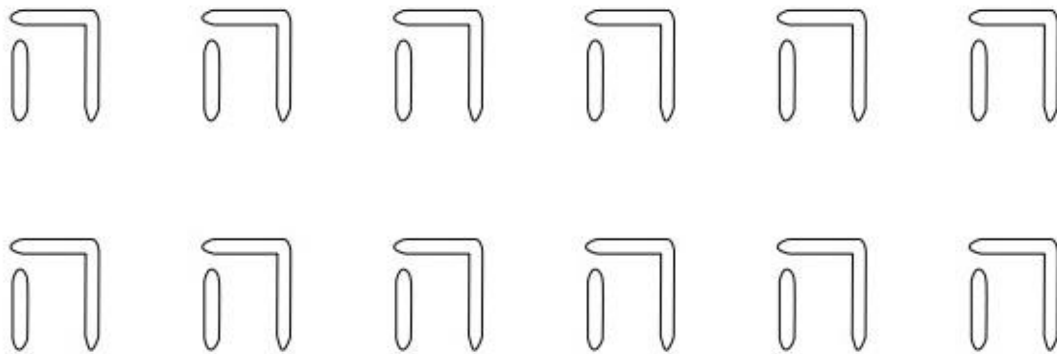
Remember to work from right to left. Start with the Hei (Hey) on the top right and trace that one first. Then move to the one to its left. When you get to the end of the row, go back to the bottom right and trace that letter.

Trace Letter Hey!

"h" as in hay



Trace the letter outline:
