Write the following Hebrew words in English letters, dividing the syllables appropriately. Pay attention to any dageshes.

Tell whether the dageshes in the following words are weak or strong.

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| 1. אֲשָׁה | 1. Strong |
| 2. בֵּין | 2. Weak |
| 3. סֵלֶם | 3. Strong |
| 4. הִנֵּה | 4. Strong |
| 5. דָּוִד | 5. Weak |

Tell whether the stress accent in the following words is on the last syllable or the first syllable.

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| 1. לְחֵם | 1. First |
| 2. כְּסָף | 2. First |
| 3. עֶפֶר | 3. Last |
| 4. בֵּית | 4. First |
| 5. קָטוֹן | 5. Last |
