1. John the Baptist wore **בְּגָד** made of camel hair.
2. The people of Israel were removed from their **אֶרֶץ** because of their idolatry.
3. Aaron said, "It's not my fault! I just threw the gold into the fire, and out popped this **צֶלֶם** of a golden calf!"
4. David said **כִּי** the Lord was his shepherd.
5. **מֶלֶךְ** David had a **יָלֵד** named Solomon.
6. God told Noah to make an ark of **עֵץ**.
7. Imagine what it was like to walk with God in the **גֵּן** in the cool of the day (Genesis 3:8).
8. God told Moses to stretch out his **יָד** over the **יָם**.
9. One of the **עֲשֵׂר** commandments is to not take the **שֵׁם** of the Lord in vain.
10. The Lord **קָרָא** to Samuel in the middle of the night.
11. The Bible tells us that Esther was the **בַּת** of Abihail.
