

## Plural Possessive Suffixes in Hebrew

\*The syllable that is stressed, or accented, is marked in bold in the pronunciation guide.  
Remember that these are PLURAL suffixes...my horses, your horses, etc.

My	<b>סוּסַי</b> (susay)
Your (masc. sing.)	<b>סוּסֶיְךָ</b> (susekha)
Your (fem. sing.)	<b>סוּסַיִכֶּךָ</b> (susayikh)
His	<b>סוּסָיו</b> (susav)
Her	<b>סוּסֵיהָ</b> (suseha)

Our	<b>סוּסֵינוּ</b> (susenu)
Your (masc. plural)	<b>סוּסֵיכֶם</b> (susekhem)
Your (fem. plural)	<b>סוּסֵיכֶן</b> (susekhen)
Their (masc.)	<b>סוּסֵיהֶם</b> (susehem)
Their (fem.)	<b>סוּסֵיהֶן</b> (susehen)
