

## Practice with Infinitive Construct Forms

(Hebrew 2 – Lesson 128)

1. Read each of the following infinitive construct forms derived from the verb **שָׁמַע**, to hear or obey. Write a possible translation next to each one. Remember the meanings we discussed for attached prepositions and personal suffixes. There will be more than one possible answer for each one.

- a. **לְשָׁמַע** in order to hear/obey
- b. **כְּשָׁמַע** when (he) heard/obeyed or hears/obeys
- c. **כְּשָׁמְעוּ** when they heard/obeyed or hear/obey
- d. **כְּשָׁמַעִי** when I heard/obeyed or hear/obey
- e. **בְּשָׁמְעוּ** when they heard/obeyed or hear/obey

2. Now read each of the following infinitive construct forms derived from the verb **יָשַׁב**, to sit or dwell. Write a possible translation next to each one.

- a. **לְשִׁבַת** in order to sit, dwell
- b. **לְשִׁבְתֵּנוּ** for us to sit, dwell
- c. **בְּשִׁבְתְּךָ** when you sit/sat or dwell/dwelt
- d. **בְּשִׁבַת** when (he) sits/sat or dwells/dwelt
- e. **בְּשִׁבְתּוֹ** when he sits/sat or dwells/dwelt
