Reasons for Exploration: Many European countries began to explore other parts of the world during the 1400s and 1500s. The reasons for this exploration were:

- 1. Many countries were searching for new spices to trade for. Spices were considered a luxury item and could be sold for high prices so merchants wanted them to sell.
- 2. Many people were trying to spread Christianity to parts of the world where Christianity was not accepted or heard of.
- 3. New technology such as compasses, maps, etc. made travel easier.
- 4. Kings and queens sent explorers in search of wealth to claim as their own.
- 5. Kings and queens wanted new lands where they could send criminals and anyone not welcome in their homelands.
